WTS Orange County Graduate Scholarships

The Women's Transportation Seminar (WTS) is an international organization of transportation professionals with more than 8,000 members, who are committed to excellence in the transportation industry. WTS seeks to break down historic barriers to entry and obstacles to success within the transportation industry by providing a neutral forum for the exchange of information, ideas, experiences, and professional development opportunities. WTS supports the professional advancement of its members and promotes industry recognition of women in the field of transportation. Part of WTS' goal of fostering the development of women in transportation can be realized by encouraging bright new professionals to take careers in the field.

In 2022, the WTS Orange County (WTS-OC) Chapter awarded 11 scholarships to students – for a total of \$50,000. The number of scholarships and the amounts for the 2023 academic year will be determined following a review of the applications received.

The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- ♦ Open to Graduate students graduating after December 2023.
- \diamond Open to women only.
- \Rightarrow GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field, such as civil engineering, transportation engineering or planning, aviation, transit, rail, business management, finance, or logistics with a focus on public policy.
- Currently enrolled in a school within Orange County, a current resident of Orange County or currently/have previous work experience in Orange County.

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation involvement and goals, job skills, and academic record. Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- ♦ Coursework, curriculum, academic performance, and recommendation
- ♦ Intent to pursue a career in transportation in Orange County
- Commitment to transportation as demonstrated by extracurricular activities and/or work experience
- Personal statement (writing and communication skills)

Applications must be completed and submitted online <u>WTS-OC Graduate Scholarship</u> <u>Online Application</u>, or downloaded and scanned as <u>a single PDF</u>, and e-mailed to the Scholarship Committee at <u>wtsocscholarship@gmail.com</u> no later than 5:00 p.m. PST on Friday, August 4, 2023.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Can I apply for more than one WTS-OC Scholarship Level per year?

A: No. You may only apply for your respective level of study per year. For example, if you are an Undergraduate Student, you would apply for the WTS-OC Undergraduate Scholarship only. If you are a High School Student, you would apply for the WTS-OC High School Scholarship only.

Q: The person I asked to write my Letter of Recommendation would like to send it to you directly. Is that allowed?

A: Yes. Though we prefer to have a complete package submitted, if your Recommender would prefer to send us your Letter of Recommendation directly, please have them include your name, the scholarship you are applying for, and "Letter of Recommendation" in an email subject line, and email us at <u>wtsocscholarship@gmail.com</u>. Please remember, Letter of Recommendations must be signed and completed on Official Letterhead.

Q: Am I eligible to apply if I'm currently attending a school outside of Orange County, but am a resident from Orange County? Am I eligible to apply if I'm not a resident of Orange County, but I'm currently attending a school in Orange County?

A: Yes, and yes. You must address your connection to Orange County's transportation industry within your Personal Statement.

Q: What qualifies as "Proof of Current Enrollment?"

A: You may submit an official "Proof of Enrollment," statement or letter from your school. A screenshot or print out of your current class schedule with valid dates of the current year, semester, and/or quarter would also be accepted. If your current Student ID shows valid dates of your current year, semester, and/or quarter, a scan of the front and back of your Student ID would work as well.

Q: I'm currently in my first semester/quarter of undergraduate/graduate study. How do I provide a copy of my Official Transcript, when I have not completed courses yet?

A: If you are in your first semester/quarter of your undergraduate study, you may submit an Official Transcript from your High School. If you are in your first semester/quarter of your graduate study, you may submit an Official Transcript from your Undergraduate School.

<u>Note</u>: Your application will not be considered if you do not submit a copy of your transcript and letter(s) of recommendation on official letterhead, along with all other application materials in one PDF by the date and time listed above.

Helene M. Overly Memorial Graduate Scholarship

The WTS Helene M. Overly Memorial Scholarship was established in 1981 by WTS International to encourage women to pursue career paths in transportation. The scholarship is awarded to women pursuing graduate studies in transportation or a related field.

In memory of Helene M. Overly, the first Executive Secretary of WTS, the Board of Directors voted to name the annual WTS graduate scholarship the Helene M. Overly Memorial Scholarship to honor Helene for her dedicated service to WTS. Helene became a WTS member in 1981. She brought with her 15 years of experience in public service, tremendous organizational abilities, and a spirit of determination that helped WTS nearly double its membership in two years.

Leadership Legacy Scholarship

WTS launched the Leadership Legacy Scholarship in 2007. Through this award, WTS provides a scholarship to an outstanding young woman pursuing graduate studies working toward a career in transportation or a related field, and who demonstrates a specific interest in advancing transportation innovation.

The WTS mission to build the transportation industry through the global advancement of women can be realized by encouraging women to further their careers as leaders in transportation. WTS recognizes that transportation is more than simply moving people and goods from one place to another. It is a driver of growth and an integral part of communities throughout the world. The leadership, skills, and perspectives of women are essential to ensure that the transportation systems of the future respond to the needs of all.

VI. Proof of Enrollment: Attach a copy of your tuition receipt or current registration card.

VII. Transcript: Obtain a copy of your transcript from your school's Registrar and have it emailed to yourself. Print and scan the copy of your transcript, and include it with your application packet. Please note that if you are selected as a winner, you will be required to submit an <u>official transcript</u>.

VIII. Provide a Short Biography: A brief (75-100 words) biographical summary written in 3rd person perspective to be included in the event program if you are selected as a winner. Please attach to the application form as a typed word document. Here's an example:

Jane Doe is a Civil Engineering major at the University of California, Irvine. In the future, she aspires to own a civil engineering consulting company. Her goal is to help build safe infrastructure and improve the current transportation system in the US. She is an active member of WTS-OC Student Chapter and has worked as an intern at the City.
